A. BRIEF INTRODUCTION TO KNB SCHOLARSHIP

Kemitraan Negara Berkembang Scholarship, popularly known as KNB Scholarship, is a financial assistance offered by the Indonesian Government to prospective international students coming from developing countries to pursue their master's degree in one of Indonesian universities. The scholarship was conceived in the 10th Conference of Heads of States of Non-Aligned Movement (NAM) countries, 1st–6th September 1992. The Government of Republic of Indonesia began to offer the scholarship to potential students from NAM member countries in the following year.

The regional exclusiveness of the scholarship was revoked in 2002 since it had developed global interest. It was then the scholarship was officially renamed as *Kemitraan Negara Berkembang* Scholarship (KNB) and the recipients were no longer limited to NAM member countries. To date, the scholarship has also been offered to other developing countries in Asia, Pacific, South America, Africa, and Eastern Europe. Eventually, the scholarship is expected to build the people-to-people relations between Indonesia and the recipient countries. It aims at nurturing their future leaders.

KNB offers an experience of studying in top universities in Indonesia and at the same time living in one of the world's most diverse and vibrant society. By getting the scholarship, students will experience quality postgraduate programs managed by the twenty university partners. Their degrees will enhance their intellectual standing, develop their competencies, and open wider professional opportunities, a foundation for post-college success. Certainly, they will also be able to enjoy first-hand experience of living in a multicultural and multilingual society.

B. PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

1. To contribute in the human resource development in the developing countries;
2. To promote deeper cultural understanding between developing countries;
3. To strengthen the relationship and cooperation between developing countries.

D. PROGRAM STRUCTURE

1. Indonesian Language Training Program

A one academic year Indonesian Language (Bahasa) course is a compulsory for all KNB students as all courses required to complete the academic program (lecture and thesis) will be conducted in Bahasa. The Bahasa course will be provided by each University.

2. Preparatory Program

Preparatory program prior to the academic program will be arranged in accordance with the university's policy and program planning.

3. Academic Program

The maximum length of scholarship disbursement:

a. 6 semesters for Doctorate Degree program. There are two schemes of doctorate degree offered under the scholarship: Doctorate program by Research and Doctorate program by a combination of coursework and research. An extension of maximum 2 semester can be granted on case-by-case assessment on the candidates individual specific case.

b. 4 semesters for Master Degree program.

c. 8 semesters for Bachelor Degree program.

In order to successfully complete the program, it is important for all KNB awardees to consistently produce a good academic performance by developing a can do attitude, stay focus, as well as being punctual, and discipline.



E. SCHOLARSHIP COVERAGE AND DURATION

The KNB Scholarship covers:

1. A Settlement allowance of IDR 1,500,000 will be given to new students upon their arrival in Indonesia;
2. While taking the Indonesian language course and preparatory programs, the new students will only receive living allowance and book allowance that will be distributed monthly;
3. During the Academic Program, the KNB students will receive monthly allowance that consists of living allowance and research and book allowance;
4. A health insurance with a maximum of IDR 400,000 monthly premium (In case of the cost of medical services exceeded to those covered by the health insurance, the difference should be borne by the student);
5. A round-trip international airfare (economy class) from the international airport of the student's home countries to Indonesia, including local transport to the host university;
6. The duration of scholarship is exclusively correlated to the duration of the academic program as indicated below:

1.	Indonesian Language Course and Master Preparatory Program	Maximum 12 months
2.	Doctorate Program	Maximum 36 months (6 semesters)
3.	Master Program	Maximum 24 months (4 semesters)
4.	Bachelor Program	Maximum 48 months (8 semesters)

7. Please be advised that the KNB Scholarship is calculated to support the KNB Student costs only. There is no provision for dependents. KNB Students are advised not to bring dependents to Indonesia. The KNB Scholarship provides no financial or pastoral support for dependants and will not endorse the visa applications of, nor provide travel for, dependants.

* Note: Other expenses beside above menoned items will be considered as personal expenses and will be borne by the students.

F. REQUIREMENTS

REQUIREMENTS FOR DOCTORATE DEGREE SCHOLARSHIP

1. The maximum age to apply for the scholarship is 40 years old.
2. Hold a master degree (please provide the scanned degree certificate and academic transcripts in English). Please be advised that Doctorate degree holder is not eligible to apply.
3. Obtain a recommendation letter from the potential research supervisor in one of the universities providing partner of the KNB Scholarship.
4. Provide a statement of purpose that at least states the purpose of their studies, the origin of their interests in studying in Indonesia and pursuing their chose research topic and their plans for the academic future.
5. Have a TOEFL or IELTS (or other cerfied English Proficiency Test) score of 90 TOEFL IBT or 7.0 IELTS or equivalent (the cerfcate must be obtained within the last 2 Years).
6. Provide the recommendation letter to apply for the KNB scholarship from the Indonesian Embassy or the Indonesian Consulate General.
7. Attach a letter of recommendation for the KNB Scholarship application from the employer/direct supervisor
8. Prove of citizenship (Official Passport or Personal ID).
9. Attach a letter of recommendation from previous universities.
10. Complete the online application form.

REQUIREMENTS FOR MASTER DEGREE SCHOLARSHIP

1. The maximum age to apply for the scholarship is 35 years old.
2. Hold a bachelor degree (please provide the scanned degree certificate and academic transcripts in English). Please be advised that master degree holder is not eligible to apply for the Master Degree scholarship.
3. Have at least the IBT TOEFL score of 80, or IELTS score of 6.0, or TOEIC score of 700 (the certificate must be obtained within the last 2 Years).
4. Provide the recommendation letter to apply for the KNB scholarship from the Indonesian Embassy or the Indonesian Consulate General.
5. Provide recommendation letter to apply for the KNB scholarship from The employer/immediate supervisor.
6. Provide Academic Recommendation Letter from previous schools.
7. Prove of citizenship (Official Passport or Personal ID).
8. Complete the online application form.

REQUIREMENTS FOR BACHELOR DEGREE SCHOLARSHIP

1. The maximum age to apply for the scholarship is 25 years old.
2. Hold a High School degree (please provide the scanned degree certificate and academic transcripts in English). Please be advised that bachelor degree holder is not eligible to apply for the Bachelor Degree scholarship.
3. Have the English Proficiency Test Score as follows: IBT TOEFL of 80, IELTS of 6.0, TOEIC of 700 (the certificate must be obtained within the last 2 Years).
4. Provide the recommendation letter to apply for the KNB scholarship from the Indonesian Embassy or the Indonesian Consulate General.
5. Provide recommendation letter to apply for the KNB scholarship from The employer/immediate supervisor.
6. Provide Academic Recommendation Letter from previous schools.
7. Prove of citizenship (Official Passport or Personal ID).
8. Complete the online application form.

G. HOW TO APPLY

All application process is conducted online through the KNB Scholarship website <https://knb.kemdikbud.go.id>. Please be advised that solicing is prohibited.

Application Procedures

1. Download the Invitation Letter from the KNB Scholarship website;
2. Submit the Invitation leer, Passport, Academic Certificates and Academic Transcripts to the Indonesian Embassy or Indonesian Consulateto acquire the recommendation letter;
3. Complete the online application process;
4. Selecon process;
5. The Selection Results will be broadcasted online through the KNB Scholarship Website and officially announced through the Indonesian Embassy publication network;

During the application process, please pay close aenon to some importantinformaon below:

1. We strongly suggest you to collect as many informaon as possible on the universities and your desired study program. Please be advised that once you are admitted, changing either the universities or your study program is strictly prohibited.
2. The recommendation letter from Indonesian Embassy is mandatory. The recommendation letter will be issued based on verification and necessary background and/or security checks conducted by the Indonesian Embassy. In case of no Indonesian official representative in your country, you need to obtain the letter from any Indonesian Embassy accredited to your country.
3. All the required documents have to be written or officially translated In English.

4. The participants from English speaking country are not automatically excluded from the requirement to pass the written test of their English proficiency.
5. The universities will be conducting the selection process that should include (if necessary) online interview with the potential candidates.

H. SCHEDULE

1. The online application process must be completed no later than February 18th, 2023.
2. The selection result will be announced on the 1st week of June 2023.
3. The confirmation deadline is on July 23rd, 2023.
4. The new KNB awardees are expected to arrive in Jakarta on second week July, 2023.


